Continuing our work in developing a network of partners to address the need of raising aspirations of young women to look at non-traditional trades and STEM, the Trade Career For You webinar in was held November 2021.

The 2021 Youth Career Expo 2021 took place in March at the Central Ringwood Community Centre. 110 attendees benefited from the expertise of career professionals, employers and young apprentices across various presentations and conversations

Recognising a gap in local students preparation for entering the workforce, OELLEN facilitated multiple practice interviews. 10 schools engaged in this program resulting in over 26 sessions benefiting over 400 students. One student even credited their successful interview the following day to the feedback they received!
